Lochaber Cemetery

The first settlers came to Lochaber in 1807 and were mostly from Argyleshire, Scotland. After the long ocean voyage to Montreal, they proceeded on smaller boats to landing places on the Ottawa River, possibly at Plaisance or Thuro. They then walked to their lots. Later a landing was made on the Ridge between the Ottawa River and Lochaber Bay.

Although there is no record of the first burial at Lochaber, there is a tale that a man died before a site for a cemetery had been chosen. A rough coffin was made and men started to carry the body to Buckingham for burial. It was a warm day and the bearers soon realized that they could not complete the journey. They then buried their friend beside the trail. R. J. MacLachlan who told the story said that the grave was located near the Half Way House, but no one knows the site nor the identity of the man.

Possibly because of transportation problems on the narrow trails, many farms had small private burial plots. The first community cemetery was on the Bay Hill on the Campbell lot.

(I am condensing a report from The Buckingham Post of the first Memorial Service held on May 24, 1959.)

The present cemetery dates back to at least 1839 when Alexander MacCallum was buried there in one of his son's fields at the age of eighty, having been born on the Island of Iona the same year as Robbie Burns. (See Stone # 24).

Unlike many country churchyards the Lochaber cemetery has never been allowed to become neglected and run-down. There were always those who cared enough to keep it in a state of decent repair.

In 1957 a new committee was formed and there was a fresh wave of interest. The old hedge was taken out and a modern ranch style fence was built along the front. Letters were sent to those who had parents or grandparents buried at Lochaber. The response was overwhelming.

and a trust fund was set up to ensure that the grounds etc. would be looked after for years to come.

On Memorial Day the cemetery looked its best. Fresh flowers were on every grave, the grass was green, and Lochaber Bay, sparkling in the sun, made an attractive backdrop. About 150 friends gathered from near and far.

Pipe Major John MacKenzie of the R.C.A.F. played "Lochaber No More". Anne Lamb and Linda MacCallum dressed in Highland costume took up the collection. Mrs. Evans sang an old familiar hymn, "Our Years are Like the Shadows on Sunny Hills that Lie:" without accompaniment and, as her magnificent voice soared across the green landscape, her listeners had a sense of being one with those who must have sung this hymn many times and were now silent.

Rev. Creelman of Ottawa then spoke simply and sincerely of those pioneers who had crossed the Atlantic from Scotland in sailing vessels in the early years of the 19th. century. He commended their sense of adventure, their bravery in the face of great odds, and above all their sense of the presence of God. They hewed clearings out of the wilderness, planted crops, built houses, schools, churches - always a church.

Armed with their faith (in God and themselves, in freedom of education) they were able to face the worst that nature could throw at them and built a civilization of which we, with our cars, TV sets, oil furnaces etc., are the benefactors.

There was a closing prayer, the piper played "The Flowers of the Forest", Rev. Creelman pronounced the benediction and the service closed with "God Save The Queen". Refreshments were served by the Committee and the gathering ended in an informal picnic.

Since the first Memorial Service others have taken place. The cemetery has been enlarged again (1982) with land donated by Malcolm (Mac) and Arthur MacCallum. For many years Mac was caretaker of the cemetery. He passed away in 1981 and is buried beside his brother Thomas.

The year 1984 marks the 145th. anniversary of the burial of Alexander MacCallum. It is also the 25th. anniversary of the first Memorial Service.



Location

Lochaber Cemetery is situated in the 2nd Range of the Municipality of Lochaber West and is north of Highway 148. About four miles from Thuroso and five miles from Masson the highway runs parallel to the CPR track. On this stretch is a sideroad running north. Turn on to this sideroad and proceed a short distance to the STOP sign. Turn left and you will reach the cemetery in less than $\frac{1}{2}$ mile.
